Report on WTL Activity, Thursday March 27 2015

The room where this fourth WTL workshop began, at about 11.30 am, was too small to contain all the people eager to hear and discuss about *Religion, Politics and Liberation*. The workshop was introduced and moderated by Kochurani Abraham and four presentations were made in the following order: Sonia Dayan-Herzbrun *Secularity, Religions, Emancipation*, Adam K. Arap Chepkwony, *The Kenyan Constitution, Politics and the Christian Church: Who Will Speak for the Voiceless?*, Lee Cormie, *Epistemologies of the South: New Spaces for Hope(s) and Faith(s)*, Maria Pilar Aquino, *Justice and Gratitude: Embracing the World Forum on Theology and Liberation*. Participants were invited, as the day before, to divide in two groups, according to the language they preferred to use (English or French), and to discuss the presentations. Very intense comments and discussions went on during 40 minutes in each of these groups. In the third part of the session, everybody gathered again in one room, and listened to the reports from each of the two groups. The session ended after a few final comments, but it looked as if many people wished to go on with these exchanges. Then members of WTL met for a brief evaluation. Many positive points came out. Among them the presence in the audience of many young people, from different backgrounds, really interested in the issues being discussed. Also remarkable has been the fact that a group of persons attended all the sessions, and we're obviously deeply interested. All of this is seen as very real encouragement for continuing WFTL participation in the WSF.
